



## Driving Directions to the KLT's Hungarian Falls Nature Area

From Hancock:

1. Head North on M-26, following signs for Lake Linden
2. Continue on M-26 for about 8 miles
3. In Tamarack City, turn Left onto 6th Street across the street from the ruins of the stamp mill
4. Immediately take the Left fork onto Golf Course Road, which heads up the hill
5. Follow Golf Course Road up the hill for about 0.5 miles
6. On your left will be an old yellow/orange fire gate and a rough road that leads to the Nature Area. Please park on the shoulder of Golf Course Road near here; the access road is in poor condition and is only traversable by vehicles with 4wd and high clearance. Parking is limited near the dam and it is less than ¼ mile to hike in.
7. Once parked, hike along the road until you reach the dam. The uppermost Hungarian Falls are above the pond to your right.

Please note: in winter, Golf Course Road is unplowed for most of its length. The road is not plowed from the bottom of the hill, so you will have to park on 6<sup>th</sup> Street and hike up the road on snowshoes. Respect the neighbors at the bottom of the hill! Golf Course Road is plowed a short distance in from the northern end on top of the hill and is a shorter hike to the uppermost falls. The parking area in summer along the road is located at 47.173159, -88.444743 if using a GPS device.
