

## Driving Directions to the KLT's Huron Bay Field Station

## From L'Anse:

- 1. From US-41, head towards Downtown L'Anse via East Broad Street
- 2. At the 4-way stoplight, turn <u>Right</u> onto North Main Street. Continue through town. North Main Street will turn into <u>Skanee Road</u>
- 3. After 9.3 miles, turn Left onto Townline Road, following signs for Aura
- 4. Just before the pavement ends on Townline Road (4.6 miles), turn Right onto Point Abbaye Rd
- 5. In 3.2 miles, turn <u>Right</u> onto a driveway just past Reeds Point Road. Look for where the power lines head into the forest.
- 6. Follow the access road until you reach the locked gate for the Huron Bay Field Station

Point Abbaye Road may be rough at times and often have muddy patches after spring snowmelt. The access road leading into the nature area is very rough with many deep potholes that may damage low-clearance vehicles. Point Abbaye Road is plowed to beyond where the Huron Bay Field Station driveway is located. However, the access road is not plowed in winter. Plan to park along Point Abbaye Road and snowshoe or ski in.

The property is currently surrounded by a tall wire fence which prevents access from the outside for both deer and people. In order to protect the ongoing research taking place inside the property, please keep the gates closed at all times. The gates are normally locked at the access road.
