



Driving Directions to the KLT's Le Chance Creek Nature Area

From Hancock:

1. Head North on M-26, following signs for Lake Linden
2. Continue on M-26 for 10.7 miles past the Lift Bridge
3. In Lake Linden, turn Right onto 9th Street for Bootjack Road, just before the yellow blinker
4. Stay on Bootjack Road for 8 miles
5. At Dreamland Bar, turn Left onto Jacobsville Road
6. After 6.3 miles, turn Left onto Sandstone Road
7. In 1.6 miles, turn Left onto Red Rock Road at the intersection
8. At the next intersection, turn Right onto the DNR access road

Once you have reached the Michigan DNR land, you must then travel another 0.75 – 1 mile north through the woods on foot to access the Le Chance Creek Nature Area. There are no marked trails and any logging roads may be overgrown. Alternately, you can launch your kayak or canoe at the DNR beach and paddle directly to the Le Chance Creek shoreline. The DNR access road is seasonal and not plowed in winter. GPS coordinates for the cobble beach at the nature area are 47.036527, -88.362003. GPS boundaries of the property are available by request through the KLT office.
