Lightfoot Bay Cabin Use

This protected natural area is open to the public for low impact recreational activities such as hiking and paddling. Your scheduled use of the cabins is exclusive, but you may encounter other day use visitors. Please be courteous but you are not expected to 'host' other day visitors. Please park and drive only in the area right behind the cabins -- foot traffic only on the rest of the preserve land. KLT will inform you as to winter parking and arrangements for keys to the cabins.

The main cabin has three bedrooms each with a full-sized bunk. The winter cabin has two sleeping areas each a single bunk over a double bunk. Each cabin is equipped with: electricity, hot and cold running water seasonally, inflatable mattresses and pump, small refrigerator, microwave, electric range, tableware and cookware, and maps of area. Water is suitable for cooking and washing but is well water with a taste of iron so it is advisable to bring your own drinking water and essential to carry in water for winter use. Firewood is provided for the woodstove in the winter cabin and fireplace in the main cabin. No outside fires. There are two outhouses for use by all visitors (no indoor toilet). There are two canoes with paddles and personal flotation vests that you may use at your own risk, please use caution as the wind can really pick up off Lake Superior. Fishing is allowed in accordance with all state regulations. Pets are allowed only by prior arrangement with KLT staff and only in the winter cabin.
